**RULES BY HEATHER**

When entering the green, take care to not step on the line of other's putts. It's a good practice to always mark your ball. For some, another ball on the green can be a distraction. It also gives you an opportunity to check your ball and clean in. Remember to use a small round disc placed carefully behind your ball as a mark.

As on the fairway, the ball farthest from the hole is putt first. If you find yourself left with a short putt, it's courtesy to ask to finish before putting out of turn. The close proximity of players can be a distraction so keep talking and movements to a minimum.

The greens are possibly the most fragile place on a course. A good rule of thumb is to repair at least two ball marks on every green. Be careful when removing your ball from the cup or replacing the flag stick so as not to damage the edge of the cup. Leave the greens in a condition that you would like to find them.

When leaving the green, replace the flag stick and then leave the area in a timely manner so the next group can take their approach to the green. It's best to move on to the next tee box to check score cards and mark scores. Heather Cooper, Rules Chairperson
