**RULES BY HEATHER:**

**8-1. Advice**

During a stipulated round, a player shall not give advice to anyone in the competition except his partner and may ask for advice only from his partner or either of their caddies. What this ruling basically means is that any advice given or taken that might influence a competing player, earns a two-stroke penalty.

Examples of seeking advice: "What club did you just use?" "Help me, what's wrong with my swing?" "How far is my ball from that bunker?"

Examples of giving advice: Unfortunately, answering any of the above questions. "If you tee it a little higher, you might get better contact." Making a suggestion on how to chip onto a green.

Permissible actions: Glancing discretely at a player's bag to see what club is missing. Asking for yardage from a permanent object (such as a tree or yardage marker) to determine distance to another Permanent object (such as the green or sand bunker). Asking what club a player used on a previous hole.

There are some real fine lines in this ruling and I would strongly suggest checking out the rules section at <http://www.usga.org/rules/>.
