Captain's Corner:

From City of Kent Website: Green River Levee Project Set to Begin KENT, WA – June 9, 2008 – King County and the Army Corps of Engineers have scheduled work to begin next week on an important levee improvement project to protect the Kent Valley. Work will begin on or around June 16, with actual levee construction beginning July 1. The project will impact two of Kent's most popular amenities: Riverbend Golf Complex and the Green River Trail. **Golfers, take note: The 18-hole course will remain open until September 1. It will then be restricted to a 9-hole operation during the construction phase, with the re-opening of the full 18-hole course scheduled for March 2009.** There will be no interruptions on the Par-3 course. Green River Trail users will be detoured around the construction site via Frager Road. Look for posted detour signs. For more information about the trail detour, contact the Parks Department at 253-856-5110. Questions about the Green River levee project may be directed to Mike Mactutis, Public Works Environmental Engineering Manager at 253-856-5520.

Marking Time

by Anne Tuttle Rules and Bylaws

In order to speed up play, it is often expedient to mark and lift another player's ball on the putting green. If this happens, who can replace the ball to the spot from which it was lifted or moved?.....It does not have to be the person who marked and lifted the ball. Any one of **three** people can replace the ball:

- 1) the player
- 2) the player's partner
- 3) the person who marked and lifted the ball.

Remember the player is responsible for any breach of the Rules even if the ball is replaced by someone else.

On a similar subject, when a ball is replaced on the putting green, at what point is it considered to be back in play?

- a) when the ball is replaced
- or

- b) when the mark is lifted

Rule 20-4 states that the ball is in play on the putting green when it has been replaced, so it is in play whether or not the mark has been lifted.

If the ball is moved when in play by the player, their partner or their equipment, it results in a one stroke penalty and the ball **MUST** be replaced. If the ball is not replaced and the player makes a stroke at the ball it is then a two stroke penalty.

Remember the player is responsible for any breach of the Rules even if the ball is replaced by someone else.
