Golf Etiquette 101 from the USGA website:

Unlike many sports, golf is for the most part played without the supervision of a referee, umpire or coach. The game relies on the individual golfer to show consideration for other players and to abide by the rules. New golfers are often in need of advice about customary behavior and practices to follow on course so that play proceeds safely and without delay. Here are 10 tips to help all players get the maximum enjoyment from the game.

The Spirit of the Game

Unlike many sports, golf is played, for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players and to abide by the Rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be. This is the spirit of the game of golf.

Safety

Players should ensure that no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club, the ball or any stones, pebbles, twigs or the like when they make a stroke or practice swing.

Players should not play until the players in front are out of range.

Players should always alert greenstaff nearby or ahead when they are about to make a stroke that might endanger them.

If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, he should immediately shout a warning. The traditional word of warning in such a situation is "fore."

Consideration for Other Players

No Disturbance or Distraction

Players should always show consider-

ation for other players on the course and should not disturb their play by moving, talking or making any unnecessary noise.

Players should ensure that any electronic device taken onto the course does not distract other players. On the teeing ground, a player should not tee his ball until it is his turn to play.

Players should not stand close to or directly behind the ball, or directly behind the hole, when a player is about to play. View Avoiding Distraction Animation

On the Putting Green

On the putting green, players should not stand on another player's line of putt or when he is making a stroke, cast a shadow over his line of putt.

Players should remain on or close to the putting green until all other players in the group have holed out.

Scoring

In stroke play, a player who is acting as a marker should, if necessary, on the way to the next tee, check the score with the player concerned and record it. View Scoring Etiquette Animation

Pace of Play

Players should play at a good pace. The Committee may establish pace of play guidelines that all players should follow. It is a group's responsibility to keep up with the group in front. If it loses a clear hole and it is delaying the group behind, it should invite the group behind to play through, irrespective of the number of players in that group. Players should be ready to play as soon as it is their turn to play. When playing on or near the putting green, they should leave their bags or carts in such a position as will enable quick movement off the green and towards the next tee.

If you use the RLGA calender you should note the revision date is in the upper right hand corner. The ProShop makes monthly updates to our calender in the event the weekly tee times have been moved to accommodate tournaments.

Practice Makes Perfect written by Midge Patten, submitted by Anne Tuttle
Let's begin with a few questions about practice. Take a guess and then we will talk about the correct answers.

Q 1- I live on the golf course. Can I play the hole I live on, to help me get warmed up before our competition?

Q 2- While playing, I find a ball that I know belongs to a friend on the next fairway over. I know it's not her ball in play. Can I use my 8 iron and hit it over to where she is, since I can't throw that far?

Q 3- Play seems to be slow today. After finishing the first 9 I can see our group can't hit yet on Hole 10. Can I stop and putt on the

practice green until the group in front clears?

Q 4- Our group just holed out. The group in front of us just left the tee on the next hole. No one is yet behind us. I've thought about using a long putter, but so far haven't tried one. One of my fellow competitors has one. Can I borrow her putter and practice putt on the green while we are waiting?

OK guys, no cheating! Think of your answers before going on.

A 1- Can I play on my own hole to get warmed up before my round? The Rules of Golf prohibit such action in stroke play, however if we are playing a match it's OK.

A 2- As to the second situation the decisions on the rules allow a person to return a ball to another player with a short iron, since it's a courtesy, and not actual practice.

A 3- During a round, I'm allowed to practice on the green of the hole last played, any practice putting green, or the teeing ground of the next hole to be played in the round.

A 4- As to borrowing another players club to practice with between the play of two holes, the answer is no penalty. Such practice is permitted by Rule 7-2. The borrowing of the putter does not breach Rule 4-4a since the putter was not used to make a stroke that counted in the player's

An unofficial announcement garnered from the February 2 RLGA Board Meeting, In 2009 the Competitions started April 1 and ran through August. In 2010, Competitions will begin on April 16th and run through September, adding two weeks to the overall schedule. For those of you who might need an explanation as to just what are competitions...every two weeks you can enter your score from an event where you played at Riverbend with at least one other RLGA member (just drop your signed and attested score card in the slot box in the ProShop.) You should also compute your score to the particular game that is being played during that particular two weeks period. To avoid playing as many as 14 times and taking your best score you are supposed to sign up for the competition in advance of playing the round. RLGA pays out for three places, now 11 times a season \$20, \$15 and \$10. Every-time you play at Riverbend with another RLGA member you should also be filling out a pink card. Pink cards are found in the RLGA corner of the Pro Shop.

As an aside, all members are invited to RLGA board meetings. Time and Dates are in the RLGA calendar. Just come on by and help in the planning and execution of your RLGA.

From your newsletter editor, Mary Ryan. RLGA neither regularly publishes this schedule in "The Fore" or inserts the dates into our calendar. If you think you might want to play in any of these events (comprised mostly of men) save this 2010 itinerary and/or contact AGA to get on their e-mail list. This 2010 schedule is posted as additional RLGA membership benefit to give RLGA members to the opportunity to play these (mostly) private courses. I played in a WSGA event at Wing Point several years ago and tried unsuccessfully to get back on that private course for another try at it. Looks like July 26th is my chance.
